
COMMUNICATION

Please keep your child's teacher updated with any concerns you have. We want your child's transition back to school to be as smooth and enjoyable as possible.






















Staff have really enjoyed the opportunity to look through the students' remote learning books. Families have certainly done an amazing job supporting their children's learning throughout this time.










